## DROVE ORCHARD THORNHAM

Nestled in the forty or so acres of active orchards in Thornham is Drove Orchards. With over twenty business including shops, restaurants, hairdressers and ice cream parlour! And plenty of free parking, its the ideal place to spend an afternoon relaxing shopping browsing and eating & drink with friends. The Farm Shop has a wide range of produce from around Norfolk. It is a great one-stop-shop with everything you might need including a full butchery counter, deli, a wide array of fruit and vegetables, household staples and general groceries and plenty of local wines and beers.

Visitors are welcome to explore and enjoy the orchards. Springtime is magical when the blossom is on the trees but the tastiest time to visit is from mid-late Summer and Autumn when the fruits are ready for picking. Why not visit the 'Pick Your Own' orchard, a great activity to keep children entertained and engaged.



## HOLT

Holt's fine 18th century Georgian buildings make the town one of the most attractive in north Norfolk. The town is home to many art galleries, antique and book shops and places to eat located along the high street and tucked away in hidden, charming courtyards and alleyways.

A great way to visit is via the steam from Sheringham which runs a regular service and you can catch a bus from the station straight into the town.

A whole day can be lost to exploring all that Holt has to offer and we recommend you do if you haven't done so already.



## BURNHAM MARKET

Beautiful Burnham Market is a must visit for shopping, browsing and eating & drinking. You'll find everything from the famous Hat Shop to wonderful local caught fish at Gurney's, books, antiques, art and fine dining at Socius, Hoste Arms and No29.

During the summer months the village holds its auction on the green each monday from 1-5pm, which is well a worth a browse. We do suggest arriving early as it does tend to get very busy later in the afternoon with limited parking around the green, however more public parking has now been added to the back of the main highstreet.



## WELLS-NEXT-THE-SEA

There is lots of great shops to discover in Wells, from the many book shops, galleries and giftshops to homewares, clothing and eateries. Most can be found along the main Staithe Street, which runs from the quay up the hill to Station Road.

Our particular favourites are BTOI & Nomad for truly unique gifts and homewares, Crabpot Books, the Old Wells Pottery and Bookshop and Wells Antique Centre.
